

O ddinosoriaid i bontydd

Rydych chi'n sefyll ar galchfaen. Mae'r graig yn llawn o ffosiliau, sy'n cynnwys cregyn braciopod a rhannau o goesau'r lili fôr o'r enw crinoidau. Efallai y gwelwch chi ffosiliau cwrel hefyd. Mae'r graig yn tua 340-280 miliwn o flynyddoedd oed, mae hynny'n hŷn na'r dinosoriaid. Mwynhewch edrych am ffosilau, ond cofiwch fod yr ardal hon wedi'i diogelu ac ni ddylech dynnu na thorri ffosilau i'w hagar.

From dinosaurs to bridges

You are standing on limestone. The rock is full of fossils, which include shells of brachiopods and parts of the stems of sea lilies called crinoids. You might also be able to see coral fossils. The rock is about 340-280 million years old, that's older than the dinosaurs. Please enjoy looking for fossils but remember that this area is protected and you should not remove or break open fossils.

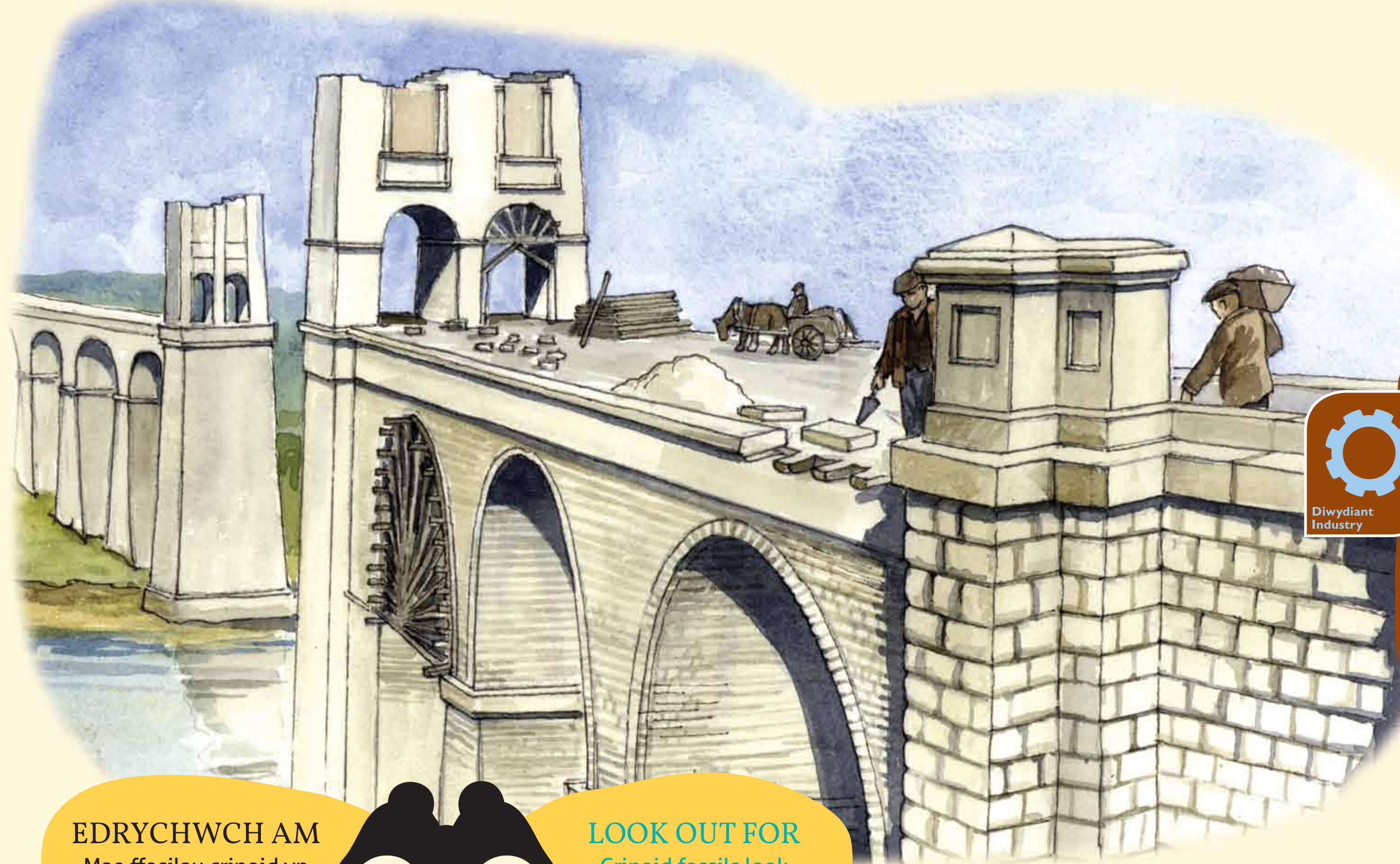


Mae calchfaen wedi cael ei gloddio ers canrifoedd a'i allforio ledled Prydain. Defnyddiwyd carreg o Borth yr Helyg i adeiladu tirnodau lleol fel Cob Conwy, Pont Grog Telford a Phont Reilffordd Diwbaid Stevenson. Gallwch weld Chwarel yr Esgob o'r fan hon, a oedd ar un adeg yn rhan o'r tir a oedd yn perthyn i Esgob Bangor.

Limestone has been quarried for centuries and exported all over Britain. The stone from Pigeon's Cove on the Great Orme was used to build local landmarks such as Conwy Cob, Telford's Suspension Bridge and Stevenson's Tubular Railway Bridge. You can see Bishop's Quarry from here, which once formed part of the land belonging to the Bishop of Bangor.
