


**Two thousand years ago on the top of this hill, known as Pen Dinas, was a hillfort. You can see circular shaped groups of stones; these are the remains of the round houses that would have been enclosed by the defences of this site. The hillfort was larger than other nearby settlements, maybe because it was a trading centre, or the seat of a powerful leader.**

Y Garreg Siglo  
The Rocking Stone

Dilynwch yr arwyddion at y graig siâp hirsgwar. Mae hon yn cael ei hadnabod fel y Garreg Siglo neu Crud Tudno. O'r Garreg Siglo, gallwch fwynhau'r golygfeydd panoramig gwych cyn dychwelyd ar hyd yr un llwybr.

Follow the waymarkers to a rectangular shaped rock. This is known as the Rocking Stone or Saint Tudno's Cradle. From the Rocking Stone you can enjoy the excellent panoramic views before returning along the same route.
