

## Castell Criccieth Criccieth Castle

Cynigia adfeilion Castell Criccieth olygfa odidog dros Fae Tremadog. Adeiladodd Llywelyn Fawr y castell ar ddechrau'r drydedd ganrif ar ddeg a chafodd ei ymestyn gan ei wŷr, y tywysog Llywelyn ap Gruffudd yn ddiweddarach. Pan goncrodd Edward I Wynedd, addasodd tŵr y gogledd i ddarparu ar gyfer catapwlt mawr. Galluogodd hyn y Saeson i wrthsefyll gwrthryfel Cymru ym 1292, ond nid yn 1404, pan gipiodd Owain Glyndŵr y castell a'i losgi i'r llawr.

### Yn edrych dros dref Criccieth

The ruins of Criccieth Castle offer a glorious vista over Tremadog Bay. Llywelyn the Great built the castle in the early thirteenth century and it was later extended by his grandson prince Llywelyn ap Gruffudd. When Edward I conquered Gwynedd he adapted the north tower to accommodate a large catapult. This allowed the English to withstand a Welsh rebellion in 1292, but not in 1404, when Owain Glyndŵr captured the castle and burned it down.
