

Castell y Bere

Saif Castell y Bere ar safle dramatig ar gerrig brig creigiog yn Nyffryn prydferth Dysynni. Cafodd ei adeiladu gan Llywelyn Fawr ar ddechrau'r 1220au. Ychwanegodd Llywelyn ap Gruffudd ato a dyma oedd caer olaf tywysogion Gwynedd i gwmpo i ddwylo Edward I ym 1283. Diwygiodd Edward I y castell a bwriadodd sefydlu tref yma, ond cafodd y castell ei ddinistrio yn ystod gwrthryfelc y Cymry ddegawd yn ddiweddarach. Mae tipyn i'w weld a'i archwilio yn y safle trawiadol hwn.

Castell y Bere is dramatically sited on a rocky outcrop in the beautiful Dysynni Valley. Built by Llywelyn the Great in the early 1220s, it was added to by Llywelyn ap Gruffudd and was the last fortress of the princes of Gwynedd to fall to Edward I in 1283. Edward I modified the castle and planned to establish a town here, but the castle was destroyed during a Welsh uprising a decade later. There is a lot to see and explore at this impressive site.
