

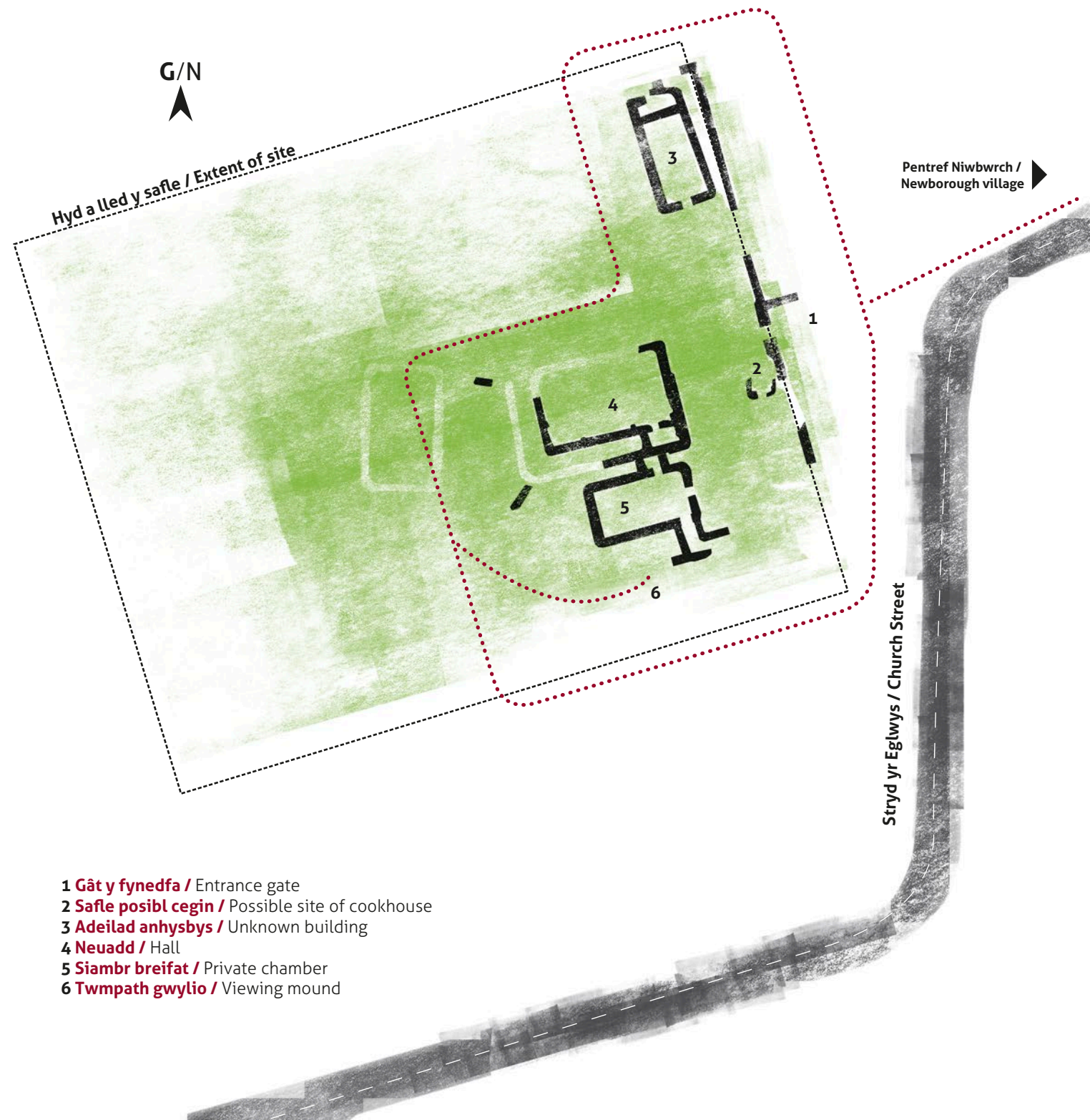
## Llys Rhosyr

Cyfle unigryw i archwilio safle llys tywysogion Gwynedd. Mae adfeilion Llys Rhosyr wedi goroesi yn sgil storm a gladdodd y safle dan dywod ym 1332. Cafodd ei leoliad ei gollu hyd nes i archeolegwyr ei ailddarganfod ym 1992. Dim ond chwarter o'r llys sydd wedi cael ei gloddio; ond mae'n hysbys fod sawl adeilad arall yn gorwedd dan y tywod. Ymhlith y sylfeini carreg o adeiladau, fe welwch neuadd fawr a siambr wely nesaf ati.

**I gyfeiriad y gorllewin o bentref Niwbwrch, rhyw ½ milltir oddi ar yr A480**

A unique chance to explore the site of a llys, or royal court, of the princes of Gwynedd. The remains of Llys Rhosyr owe their survival to a storm which buried the site beneath sand in 1332. Its location was lost until rediscovered by archaeologists in 1992. Only a quarter of the llys has been excavated; many more buildings are known to lie beneath the sand. Amongst the stone footings of buildings that you will see are a large hall and adjacent bed chamber.
